FACILITY: 25 meter x 25 yard indoor pool. Eight (8) 25 yd lanes will be used for competition. There will be one buffer lane

and two (2) warm-up-warm-down lanes. Daktronics Timing System with 10 lane scoreboard and Kiefer Wave Eater

racing lane lines.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all swimmers registered with USA Swimming. Age on February 17, 2008 will determine age for the entire meet. To be eligible to enter this meet, a swimmer must be registered with USA Swimming. no later than the entry

deadline shown below. No on-deck USA-S registration will be permitted at this meet.

The Meet Director reserves the right to limit entries in any event, if necessary, to prevent too lengthy a session, and

to combine events in which there are insufficient entries.

Inclusion Policy for Swimmers with a Disability: PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for

notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

MEET FORMAT: All events will be Timed Finals.

Swimmers may enter (5) individual events each day. All entry times must have been achieved in USA-S sanctioned or approved competition.

Dive-over starts may be used at this meet at the discretion of the Meet Manager and/or Meet Referee. Coaches are requested to review <u>Guidance for Dive-Over Starts for Coaches.</u> Officials are requested to review <u>Protocol for</u>

Dive-Over Starts.

POSITIVE CHECK-IN: After receiving the entries, the Meet Director will determine if any events will require positive check-in.

Coaches will be notified of that determination

WARM-UPS: Sunday, February 17 and Monday, February 18, 2008

If entries mailed, the following must be included. 1) a computer disk with a team manager file containing your teams entries, 2) a printout showing what is on the disk, 3) a completed summary sheet, 4) a check payable to CCS to for the full amount of the entry fees due. If entries are e-mailed, the following must be received by February11: 1) a completed summary sheet 2) a check for the full amount of the entry fees due. Any team not sending entry summary sheet and payment by the date listed above, may not be allowed to compete.

RULES:

The 2008 USA Swimming Code and Rules will apply. Potomac Valley Safety and warm-up procedures will be in effect. In accordance with Potomac Valley Swimming Policy, only those coaches who, at all times, clearly display current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

No on-deck USA Swimming registration will be permitted.

PENALTIES:

- 1. Penalties for entries using fraudulent and/or non-verifiable entry times:
 - a. Swimmer shall be disqualified from the event entered illegally.
 - b. Club may be fined up to \$100.00 for each offense, and a record of such offenses shall be kept and published as part of the official meet results.
- 2. Clubs entering swimmers not legally registered with USA Swimming by the deadline date may be fined \$100.00 per swimmer per event entered illegally.
