CHECK-IN PROCEDURE	All events 200 Yards or longer will be deck seeded. The Meet Director will determine if positive check-in will be required for any events of 100 Yards or shorter. Athletes who check in to a deck-seeded event, have been seeded, and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next scheduled individual event, unless excused by the Referee before the event takes place.					
ENTRIES	In accordance with PVS policy, team entries may be submitted by E-mail to nwright@pvfish.org (please use "2009 FISH Qualifier - *****" with the club's initials substituted in place of the asterisks. If the club is submitting entries from more than one location, please add the location to the heading with the club initials.) Events file for use in Team Manager is available for download here: "33mm020908" All entries must be Hy-Tek program entries as an attached file to e-mail. The meet director will respond to e-mails within 24 hours. If you do not receive an e-mail response within 24 hours, assume that your e-mail has not been received. It then becomes the sender's responsibility to make sure that the host club's meet director receives the e-mail. If you do not receive an e-mail response, you must contact the meet director by some means other than e-mail. Include with your commlink file one (1) report by name and one (1) by event. Create these reports in Team Manager and save as Word for Windows files. In the body of your e-mail provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals). Include contact information (e-mail, phone, officials contact). Entries may be sent via mail/express mail/etc Computer disk entries (Hy-tek) are encouraged. Disk entries require one (1) meet entry report by name and one (1) by event from Team Manager. Entries may also be submitted on a PVS Master Entry Sheet. All entries must include a completed "Entry Cover Sheet." The meet director will not accept phone or fax entries. If using a mail service (FedEx, UPS, etc) sign the waiver allowing the service to leave your entries without requiring a signature. Entries that are incomplete, submitted on incorrect forms, or lacking the phone number of a responsible club official will not be accepted and will be returned. The Meet Director will not be held responsible if there is no time to properly resubmit the entry.					
RULES	 Current USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will apply. Swimmers may enter a maximum of six (6) individual events and no more than three (3) individual events per day. The meet will be capped at 700 swimmers. Sessions #1, #2, #3 and #4 (SAT & SUN Mornings and Afternoons) are limited to a maximum of 400 swimmers per session. For events #21, 22, 62 & 63 (1000 & 1650 Free) we will be limiting that event to 2 heats apiece. If a swimmer exceeds the maximum entries, the last event, by numerical order, will be dropped. 					

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SWIMMER ELIGIBILITY	 Age on February 7th, 2009, will determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet. IMPORTANT: 14 & Under swimmers who attain a new age group between February 8th and March 19th may compete in any event where their time (1) is faster than the FISH Qualifier "No Faster Than" standard for their current age group and also (2) slower than the PVS Junior Olympic "No Slower Than" standard for their new age group. This is to permit those swimmers who will be in a new age group at the PVS Junior Olympic Meet an opportunity to qualify. An athlete may only compete in his/her own age division. Only USA Swimming registered teams will be invited to participate. All transfer swimmer(s) must swim unattached for 120 days from their last attached competition. Swimmers must use an UN- (New Team Alpha Code) as their team affiliation. To be eligible to enter this meet, a swimmer must be registered with USA Swimming and their LSC, no later than the entry deadline and have equaled or be slower than the applicable qualifying times listed (NO FASTER THAN times). 1000 & 1650 Free Eligibility For the 1000 and 1650 Free (Events #21, 22, 62 & 63) the same rule applies as above. Also, for events 21 & 22, 1000Y Freestyle Minimum provable time to enter the 1000Y Free is 15:00.00. Athletes wishing to enter the 1000 Freestyle who do not have a provable 1000Y/800M Free time under 15:00.00 must have a provable time in the 400M/500Y Free of 7:20.00 or faster. These athletes will be entered into the 1000Y Free is 25:00.00. Athletes wishing to enter the 1650 Freestyle who do not have a provable 1650Y/1500M Free time under 25:00.00 must have a provable time in the 800M/1000Y of 15:00.00 or faster. These athletes will be entered into the 1650Y freestyle with their 800M/1000Y time and will be seeded after all 1650Y/1500M times have been seeded. After times are verified, all LCM times will be
COACHES	All coaches "on the deck" must be a registered member of USA Swimming.
ELIGIBILITY	Coaches must have coaching card visible at all times.
MEET FORMAT	 The pool will be configured to conduct competition in 8-lane, 25 yard pool. All events will be swum as TIMED FINALS. Dive-over starts will be used at this meet. Coaches are requested to review Guidance for Dive-Over Starts for Coaches. Officials are requested to review Protocol for Dive-Over Starts.
WARM-UP PROCEDURES	 PVS warm-up and safety procedures will be in effect during this meet. These procedures may be found at http://www.pvswim.org/pol_proc.htm#o21. Assigned warm-ups may be used depending on the size of the meet. Deck Marshals will be assigned to supervise the warm-up sessions, and have the authority to remove any swimmer, coach, or club from the warm-up who does not follow the safety rules. All swimmers must enter the pool from the starting end of the pool.
INCLUSION POLICY FOR SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
CHECK-IN POLICY	For those events requiring positive check-in, Athletes who have not been checked-in prior to the specified time will be scratched from the event. Athletes who have checked-in, have been seeded, and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next scheduled individual event, unless excused by the Referee.

Certified officials who have not been contacted should volunteer their services to the Referee. > USA Swimming certified officials are requested for all positions. > While on the deck Officials must have current credentials visible at all times. The host club will provide a single timer in each lane throughout the meet.
HOST CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES	The meet director will create timing assignments that will be fair and equal to all teams. The timing assignments will be e-mailed to all participating clubs no later than 72 hours before the meet.
PARTICIPATING CLUB RESPONSIBILITIES	Participating clubs must help with timing assignments. Timing assignments will be sent via email to participating clubs 72 hours prior to the meet. Participating club parents must stay off the pool deck except for timing assignments. Participating clubs should help with officiating whenever possible. List the club contact for club officials with your entry summaries. Each club is responsible for supervising the conduct of their swimmers. Swimmers are not permitted in any area not directly associated with the swim meet.
AWARDS	There will be no awards at this meet.
WARNING	Any club or individual that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered swimmer to represent them, will be fined by PVS the sum of \$100.00 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine has been paid.
TEAM AREA & SUPERVISION	Teams will be inside the pool area. Due to limited space please remember to keep your area clean. Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their Swimmers and Families and for cleaning up their team areas. Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials permitted on the pool deck. Coaches & deck officials are required to display their current 2008 USA Swimming card.
ONSITE AMENITIES	 Psych Sheets will be made available by session for \$1.00 a piece. (Working officials and coaches receive a complementary program) A hospitality area will be available for USA Swimming officials and coaches.
