Awards	Ribbons will be awarded from 1 st thru 8 th place for individual events.
Eligibility	Open to all invited Potomac Valley Swimming registered athletes from AAC, HACC, Riptide, and TIBU. Athletes must be in good standing with USA Swimming and their respective LSC. Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of meet.
Swimmers with a Disability	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.
	All events are timed finals.

Rules	*A contestant may enter no more than four (4) individual events per day *200 free and 200 IM MAY require positive check-in 30 mins. Prior to warm-up based on the number of entries received for those events.		
	*Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.		
	*The Meet Manager has the right to close entries once the maximum number of splashes allotted for water time is reached.		
	*Dive over starts may be used in the 11-14 session based on number of splashes received.		
	*Parents will not be allowed on deck unless serving in an official capacity - timer, referee, judge or the like.		
	*Effective Oct. 1, 2009: In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces as per USA Swimming rules.		
	*The use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, camera PDS's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.		
	*The practice of deck changing is prohibited at all PVS Sanctioned events Swimmers participating in deck changing would be violating the USA Swimming Sportsmanship policy		
	*Swimmers in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian. (this statement can either be under RULES or SUPERVISION).		
Warm ups	The prescribed PVS Warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. Lane assignments will be posted on deck. The meet manager reserves the right to adjust warm-up times after entries are received in ord to streamline meet.		
Admission	There is no admission charge.

Seating	Seating Due to the limited pool deck space, Officials, USA Swimming Registe Coaches and Swimmers ONLY will be permitted on the pool deck. Timers	The host club will provide at least one timer per lane. Participating clubs are requested to provide at least one timer every session the team participates in proportion to their entries. Upon submission of the meet entry, clubs will be notified of the number of timers to be provided. Acceptance of the club entry is based upon compliance with the above.		
Deck Entries	Deck entries are \$10.00 per individual event and must be submitted <u>with</u> <u>payment</u> and presentation of registration card no later than 30 minutes prior to the first event of each session. No new heats will be created. First come, first served.
