As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. The practice of deck changing is prohibited at all PVS Sanctioned events. Swimmers participating in deck changing would be violating USA Swimming Sportsmanship policy. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member - coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member - coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for the 12 &U sessions in Rule 205.3.1F.
Positive Check In:	All events 200 yards or longer will be positive check-in. • The Meet Directors will determine if positive check-in will be required for all events. • Athletes who check into a deck-seeded event, have been seeded and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next schedule individual event, unless excused by the Meet/Deck Referee before the event takes place.
Warm Up:	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up; times/lane assignments.
Supervision:	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
Awards:	First through eighth place ribbons will be awards for all 12 & under events.
Programs:	All attempts will be made to have programs available for each session for a price not to exceed \$2. In the event of the entire session being positive check—in, programs may not be available until after the start of the meet. In the event that programs are not able to be sold, programs will be posted throughout the spectator areas.
Officials & Timers:	 Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee, Starter or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes All certified officials wishing to volunteer please contact the appropriate club official's chair prior to January 16. Walk-on officials are welcome and should report to the Meet Referee prior to the session. Participating clubs are required to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is required for each 25 entries. The Meet Director may send out a request for timers based upon entries.
Entry Procedures:	 Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager. Include in the subject of the email, "2012 PVS JAN OPEN - ***" with the clubs initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files. Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the meet director. Individual event fee: \$4.50 (make checks payable to PVS) Entry fees are due with meet entry. Unpaid fees will be reported to the PVS Administrative Office at the conclusion of the meet. Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club

until the said fine is paid.

NOTE: In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, Machine Aquatics, RMSC, Fairland Aquatics, Fort Belvoir Swim Team, Audrey Moore Rec Center, MLK Swim Center and Fairland Aquatic Center shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
