ELIGIBILITY:	<i>Open to all Potomac Valley athletes</i> 13 and over with 2009 – 2012 NAG 16 year old "A" times from the following clubs ONLY: RMSC, CUBU, and Machine Aquatics. The age on October 5, 2012 will determine age for the entire meet. Swimmers who qualify for 2 events are eligible to swim additional events up to the meet entry limit. Please mark bonus events as such when submitting your entries.
	It may be necessary to limit entries in certain events due to time constraints. Entries will be processed in the order that they are received.

RULES:	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet. All events are timed finals. Contestants may enter a maximum of eight individual events in the meet with no more than three events on Friday and no more than five events on Saturday. Times from long course or short course meters are acceptable if, when converted, according to the Hy- Tek Meet Mgr conversion factors, they satisfy the QT's. Submit actual times in the course achieved designating "L" or "S" as appropriate. Please mark bonus events as such when submitting your entries. Seed times are short course yards.
	In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	The practice of deck changing is prohibited at all PVS Sanctioned events. Swimmers participating in deck changing would be violating the USA Swimming Sportsmanship policy
	Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	No deck entries will be accepted.
INCLUSION POLICY:	No deck entries will be accepted. PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. NO DECK ENTRIES.
	Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return e-mail within 24 hours. Clubs submitting entries that do NOT receive an acknowledgement should contact the Meet Director by other than e-mail to confirm receipt.
WARNING:	Any club that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits unregistered coaches to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100.00 and no further entries will be accepted from that Club until the said fine has been paid.
