Participating clubs are required to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is required for each 25 entries. The Meet Director may send out a request for timers based upon entries. 	
Entry Procedures:	 Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager. Include in the subject of the email, "2013 PVS SR/AG 1 - ****" with the clubs initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files. Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the meet director. Individual event fee: \$4.75 (make checks payable to PVS) Entry fees are due with meet entry. Unpaid fees will be reported to the PVS Administrative Office at the conclusion of the meet. Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
