Open to all teams. Priority registration will be given to teams who participated in the 2013 Machine LC Classic.

Important: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.

Rules: Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet. Clubs wishing

to be invited need to contact the meet manager.

A contestant may enter a maximum of eight (8) individual events. Swimmers may compete in 2 events on Friday, 3 events on

Saturday and 3 events on Sunday.

Swimmers may participate in only his or her own age group events

based upon their age on the first day of the meet.

Dive-over starts will be used at this meet. Coaches are requested to review <u>Guidance for Dive-Over Starts for Coaches</u>. Officials are

requested to review Protocol for Dive-Over Starts.

In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker room. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's, etc.) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.

Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ENTRIES ARE SUBJECT TO CLOSING EARLY DUE TO MEET LIMITATIONS.

Meet Manager reserves the right to Positive Check-in all 200 yard events in the interest of manageable time lines.

Meet Manager also reserves the right to adjust warm-up times for all the sessions after entries have come in.

THE 800 FREE WILL BE SWUM FASTEST TO SLOWEST. 800 FREE ENTRIES MY BE LIMITED DUE TO TIME CONSTRAINTS.

The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & Under events per Rule 205.3.1F.

Inclusion Policy: PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committee

to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee

of any disability prior to competition.

Time Trials: There will be no time trials conducted at this meet.

Supervision: Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and

families and for cleaning up their team areas.

Swimmers in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA-S coach must be certified by a USA-S coach as proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. Ensuring compliance is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian.

Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches and deck officials are permitted on the pool deck. Working coaches and deck officials are required to display their 2013 or 2014 USA Swimming card.

Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer or other meet positions are not permitted on deck.

Admission: There is no admission charge.

Programs: Meet programs will be available for \$3.00 per session.

Awards: Ribbons will be awarded for 1st-8th place individual events per age

group. (10 & Under, 11-12, 13-14 and 15 & Over).

Seating: Due to the limited pool deck space, officials, USA Swimming

registered coaches and swimmers only will be permitted on the

pool deck.

Personal chairs will NOT BE permitted on the deck for coaches

only.

Swimmers will not be permitted to bring chairs on the deck.

Warning: Any club or individual that enters an unregistered athlete, falsifies

an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered swimmer to represent them, will be fined by PVS the sum of \$100.00 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine has

been paid.

Entries: Short course entry times will be considered conforming times for

this meet. Long course entry times must be designated with a capital letter "L". These non-conforming times will be seeded after

short course times. Entries should be sent via e-mail.

Entry file: Include in the subject of the email, "Machine LC Classic***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. Also, include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.

Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgment is not received in a a timely manner, please contact the meet director.

Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them, will be fined the sum of \$100 and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.

If time permits, deck entries will be accepted for \$10.00.

Fees: Fees for individual events are \$7.00 per event.
