The meet will be swum in an 8 lane course with a water depth of 7'-13' at the start end and 7'-13' at the turn end. The competition course has not been certified in accordance

with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 104.2.2(C).

TIMING SYSTEM: Semi automatic timing will be used for this meet. Three timers per lane will be required

for all 25 yard events. Swimmers in events 1-2, 31-34 are responsible to provide their

own timer and counter.

DIRECTIONS: From I-95 (North of the Capital Beltway) exit Route 212 (Powder Mill Road) East. Turn

left at first traffic light onto Old Gunpowder Road. Proceed approximately three (3)

miles to pool on left.

SCHEDULE: One session / all age groups: Warm-up 8:00 – 8:50 AM/Events: 9:00 AM. The meet

director reserves the right to limit number of entries in order to manage timeline.

ELIGIBILITY: This meet is an invitational meet. If your team would like an invitation please contact

the meet directors.

Open to USA Swimming registered athletes. Athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. An athlete may only compete in his or her own age division.

RULES: Current USA Swimming Rules shall govern the meet. In accordance with Potomac Valley

Swimming Policy only those coaches who clearly display current valid USA Swimming

credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet.

A contestant may enter five (5) events. Seed times are short course yards only. **Deck**

entries (\$10 per IE/cash only) will be accepted on a first come-first served basis,

however no new heats will be created. Evidence of current USA-S registration will be required for deck entries.

Dive-over starts may be used at this meet at the discretion of the Meet Manager and/or Meet Referee.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations; the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDS's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.

No On-Deck USA-S Registrations will be permitted.

INCLUSION POLICY:

PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or the athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to the competition.

SUPERVISION:

Coaches are responsible for supervising their swimmers and keeping their team area clean. Athletes are not permitted in any area of the facility not directly associated with the swim meet.

GENERAL:

Per facility request, no food is allowed on the pool deck except sports drink, water.

DECK ACCESS:

All PVS/USAS registered coaches and deck officials are required to display current 2016 USA Swimming membership credentials on the deck area. Anyone not displaying proper credentials will be asked to leave the deck area. Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer lane timer, or other meet position are not permitted on deck. Marshalls will be stationed around the venue to assist in compliance with this USA Swimming requirement.

WARM-UPS:

Potomac Valley Swimming Open warm-up procedures and policies will be in effect.
