Eligibility:	Open to all Potomac Valley Swimming registered athletes. Swimmers shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet. It may be necessary to limit entries due to time constraints.		
Disability Swimmers:	PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session Referee of any disability prior to competition.		
Rules:	<ul> <li>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern the meet.</li> <li>All events are timed finals.</li> <li>A swimmer may enter no more than 3 events.</li> <li>Seed times are long course meters. Converted times and coach's times are preferred over NT entries.</li> <li>No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted</li> <li>Deck entries will be accepted, and are \$10 per individual event. All deck entries must be submitted no later than 45 minutes prior to first event of each session. Swimmers will be entered into open lanes in existing heats on a first come, first served basis. In the event of a significantly over subscribed session, the Meet Director reserves the right to not accept deck entries.</li> <li>Evidence of current USA-S registration will be required for deck entries.</li> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulation, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms. As per PVS policy; the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e. cell phones, cameras, PDA's etc) are banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> <li>Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.</li> <li>Operation of a drone or any other flying apparatus is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming membercoach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4</li></ul>		
Positive Check In:	All events 200 yd and longer will be deck seeded. The Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to positive check in all events if they need to manage timelines. Athletes who check into a deck-seeded event, have been seeded and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next schedule individual event, unless excused by the		
Warm Up:	Meet Referee before the event takes place.  The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of Warm-up times/lane assignments.		
Supervision:	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
