Entry Procedures:	<ul> <li>Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager.</li> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "2017 PVS June Distance - ***" with the clubs initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.</li> <li>Meet Directors are requested to acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the meet director.</li> <li>Individual event fee: \$6.00 (make checks payable to PVS)</li> <li>Entry fees are due with meet entry.
