The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touch pads primary) will be used for this meet.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted
	<ul> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> </ul>
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	• Dive-over starts will be used at this meet. Coaches are requested to review Guidance for Dive- Over Starts for Coaches. Officials are requested to review Protocol for Dive-Over Starts.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	• There will be a Jr Circuit on Saturday, in between the 1 <sup>st</sup> and 2 <sup>nd</sup> sessions for 11-14 yr olds looking to improve or qualify for IMX events.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• All Relay check in must be done by the end of warm up for each session.
	• Saturday- Check-in for the 400 IM will be by 8:00 am
	• Saturday- Check-in for the 500 Free will be by 9:00 am
	• Check in for the 1000/1650 Free will be by 6:00 pm on Saturday.
WARM-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	• All events at the distance of 200 and below will be pre-seeded. All relays, 400 IM, 500 Free, and 1650/1000 Free will be deck seeded and require a positive check in.

	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).

	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted		
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
