TIMING SYSTEM	Semi-Automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used for this meet.		
RULES	• Current USA Swimming rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet.		
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.		
	 In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (i.e., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. 		
	Deck Changes are prohibited.		
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.		
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.		
	• Dive-over starts will be used at this meet.		
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.		
	• A contestant may enter no more than 3 events per day, or 6 events for the meet.		
	• Time constraints may require limiting the number of events that are swum.		
	• Deck entries will be accepted if space is available in existing heats.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All 200 Yard events will be positive check in.		
	• Athletes who check into a positive check-in event, have been seeded and fail to swim the event will be barred from their next scheduled individual event, unless excused by the Meet Referee.		
	Positive check in will close 30 minutes after the start of warmups		
WARM-UP	• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.		
	• There will be two forty (40) minute warmup sessions. Teams will be notified of their warm up assignments.		
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.		
	• Team Areas are outside of the pool deck in air-conditioned spaces. Swimmers are encouraged to wear appropriate clothing to maintain body warmth.		

AWARDS	 Medals will be awarded for 1st through 8th place for individual events.
	 Awards for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd will be awarded for each gender and age in the following categories:

	 Awarded based on the accumulated times for the following 6 events: 200 YD Individual Medley, 200 YD Freestyle, 100 YD Freestyle, 100 YD Backstroke, 100 YD Breaststroke, and the 100 YD Butterfly.
	• Swimmers must legally swim all six of the listed events to be eligible for the award.
	The Harvest Moon HALF MOON Award
	 Awarded based on the accumulated times for the following 6 events: 100 YD Individual Medley, 100 YD Freestyle, 50 YD Freestyle, 50 YD Backstroke, 50 YD Breaststroke, and the 50 YD Butterfly.
	• Swimmers must legally swim all six of the listed events to be eligible for the award.
PROGRAMS	• Programs will be available online no later than October 10, 2019 at <u>www.swimhacc.org</u> .

CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.

TIMERS	• The host club will provide at least 1 timer per lane. Each participating club is requested to provide at least one official and 3 timers per session if entering 25 or more swimmers.
