ELIGIBILITY	 Open to all invited Potomac Valley Swimming registered athletes from TCSD, RIPS, NCAP-Burke, and FXFX, OCCS. Athletes must be in good standing with USA Swimming and their respective LSC. 		
	 No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations Article 302. 		

DISABILITY SWIMMERS	 PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Semi Automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used for this meet.
RULES	 Current USA Swimming rules, including the <u>Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u> ("MAAPP"), shall govern this meet.
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted
	• In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	• Dive-over starts will be used at this meet. Coaches are requested to review Guidance for Dive- Over Starts for Coaches. Officials are requested to review Protocol for Dive-Over Starts.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	The 400 IM and 500 Free will be seeded fastest to slowest; heats will alternate girls/boys. Heats may be combined to meet timelines.
	• Swimmers may enter no more than four (4) events per day and no more than three (3) events per session.
	On Saturday, swimmers age 11-12 may participate in either Session 1 OR Session 3.
	• Swimmers entered in the 400 IM/500 Free will need to provide their own timer/counter.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• Events #1, #2, #3, #4, #9, #10, #23, #24, #31, #32, #39, #40, #51, #52, #61, and #62 will be positive check-in. Positive check in will close 15 minutes after the start of each warm-up session.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
AWARDS	Ribbons will be awarded from 1 st -8 th place.
PROGRAMS	Programs will be available on the SDS website (<u>www.seadevils.org</u>) and distributed prior to the

	meet. Programs will not be sold at the meet.
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	• None
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.

	 Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.

ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.
	• Include in the subject of the email, "[Polar Bear] - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet	
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
