	 In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, Patuxent Aquatic Club, and Fairlands Aquatics Center shall be held free and harmless from any and all liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of this event. 		
FACILITY	Fairland Aquatics Center 13820 Old Gunpowder Rd. Laurel, MD 20707 301-362-6060		
	 The pool at Fairland Aquatics Center is a 50m x 25yd pool with two moveable bulkheads. Competition will be held in fourteen (14) lanes, 25 yards, running from wall to wall. 		
	• The meet will be run on two (2) courses, Girls and Boys. The Girls course will be run in eight (8) lanes; the Boys course will be run in six (6) lanes.		
	Eighteen (18) lanes will be used for warm-ups.		
	• Water depth range of $5' - 13'$ at the starting end and $5' - 13'$ at the turning end.		
	• The competition course has not been certified in accordance with current <i>USA Swimming Rules</i> and <i>Regulations</i> , Article 104.2.2(C).		
ENTRY	September 27, 2021 at 11:59 p.m.		
DEADLINE	IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.

ELIGIBILITY	Open to all registered Potomac Valley Swimmers.		
	 No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 302. 		
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.		
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently.
- Locker room use should be minimized.
- No one with symptoms of COVID-19 is permitted in the facility or outside team seating area.
- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits if possible.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) must wear a mask to enter the facility
 and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming
 up/cooling down.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, volunteers, officials, etc.) must complete and turn in a COVID
 waiver and health screening form before they are permitted in the facility.
- Athletes will be seated in the outside in a fenced area with a coach/team representative. Athletes/clubs should provide their own chairs and canopies.
- All attendees should maintain a minimum of three (3) feet distance from all other participants whenever possible.
- The meet will be limited to no more than 300 swimmers.
- Only swimmers, coaches, meet volunteers, and officials will be permitted on the pool deck.
- A designated staff member, official, coach or volunteer will be in place to observe/marshal COVID-19 guidelines and report back to the coaches and officials on concerns or improvements.
- Swimmers will wear their masks until they arrive at their lane and they will take it off and place it
 in a bag. The bags will be placed in baskets by the starting blocks during warm-ups and
 competition. Swimmers will immediately put their masks back on at the completion of their
 swims before they leave the starting area.
- For the 25 yard events, volunteers will move the baskets containing masks to the finish end of the pool where the swimmers will immediately put them back on after exiting the pool.
- Swimmers must follow all directions as posted and adhere to all marshal directions.

	Swimmers will walk around the pool deck as directed and line back up in the designated area with proper social distancing until they are cleared to go back to their seating area.		
	All swimmers must remain in their designated seating area for their group until they are called for their event and they must return to their area immediately following their event.		
	• Counters for the 500 freestyle will be athletes, coaches, or volunteers already present during the session.		
	 Any swimmer not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet. 		
	All coaches, officials, and volunteers must bring their own water bottle and snacks.		
	We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID-19 after attending the meet.		
	No spectators will be permitted. Competition will be live-streamed via the Patuxent Aquatics Club Facebook page. (https://www.facebook.com/PatuxentAquaticsClub)		
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.		
	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. 		
	No on-deck USA-S registration is permitted.		
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.		
	Deck changes are prohibited.		
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.		
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.		
	• Dive-over starts may be used for ages 9 & over ONLY. For the 25 yd events, swimmers will start from the side (no blocks).		
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.		
DOCUMENT CONTROL	A swimmer may enter no more than four (4) individual events.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.		
WARM-UP	 The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments. 		
STIDEDVISION	No more than six (6) swimmers per lane.		
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.		
	 Each team MUST assign a certified Coach to remain in the assigned Team Area at ALL times to ensure COVID-19 guidelines are being followed and to assist with Clerk of Course. 		
	No spectators will be permitted in the facility.		

SEEDING	Standard seeding will be used.

CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	No spectators will be permitted in the facility.
OFFICIALS	 Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes. Officials interested in volunteering should contact Cherlynn Venit: dpws@aol.com Walk-on officials cannot be accommodated. Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups.
	 A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	 Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.
	One timer per lane. There will be two Head Timers per course.
	An online Timer's Signup will be emailed to participating clubs.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	• Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director at dpws@aol.com.
	• Include in the subject of the email, "PAC All Free Meet - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
