COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently.
- No more than four hours before entering the facility, all attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) are required to assess their own health for symptoms and exposure to COVID-19. Attendees will only be permitted entrance if answering "no" to the following questions:
 - Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
 - Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
 - Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who has in the past 14 days?
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) will enter the facility through the main entrance. Athletes will proceed to their designated Team Area in the auxiliary rooms where they are encouraged to maintain social distancing.
- Each session will be limited to 250 swimmers.
- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits if possible.
- Locker room use should be minimized. Showering will not be permitted. Non-athletes should use the family restrooms.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) must wear a mask to enter the facility
 and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming
 up/cooling down.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) must bring their own water bottle and snacks. No hospitality will be provided.

- All swimmers will need to bring a plastic bag with their name written on in which to place their mask in when they are in the water for warm-ups or competition.
- During competition athletes will proceed to the Clerk of Course located in the main hallway leading to the pool from their assigned team areas. Swimmers will then proceed from the Clerk of Course to the deck area where they will line up behind the blocks.
- Swimmers will wear their masks until they arrive at their lane for warm-ups and their scheduled events. Masks will be placed in plastic zipper bags with the swimmer's name on them. Bagged masks will be placed in bins on the bench behind each of the blocks. Swimmer will put their mask on immediately after exiting the pool.
- One-way traffic will be maintained on the pool deck at all times. Swimmers will access the pool deck through the emergency entrance door in the main hallway and will exit the pool deck through the locker rooms. They will exit the locker rooms and return to their assigned team areas using the main hallway.
- Any attendee (swimmer, coach, official, volunteer) not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet.
- Meet equipment including computers, buttons, starter, and stopwatches will be sanitized before and after each session Hand sanitizer will be provided in multiple locations around the deck and throughout the facility.
- We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID-19 after attending the meet.
- Spectators are not permitted. The competition will be live streamed on the Town of Herndon Facebook page.

RULES

- Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
- In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
- Deck Changes are prohibited.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Dive-over starts may be used. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
- No Deck Entries will be accepted.

EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	A contestant may enter no more than 3 events per day, or 6 events for the meet.
	Time constraints may require limiting the number of events that are swum.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director
	may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	There will be three twenty (20) minute warmup sessions. Teams will be notified of their warm
	up assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
	• Team Areas are outside of the pool deck in air-conditioned spaces. Swimmers are encouraged to
	wear appropriate clothing to maintain body warmth.
AWARDS	Medals will be awarded for 1st through 8th place for individual events.
PROGRAMS	 Programs will be available online <u>www.swimhacc.org</u> and emailed to attending teams no later than October 7, 2021. Programs will be available for coaches and officials at each session.
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be
	permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming
	membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	No spectators will be allowed in the building.
OFFICIALS	Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker of official (Referee)
	Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	 Officials interested in volunteering should contact Carolyn Kotarski, ckotarski@gmail.com prior to October 2nd. Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the Meet Referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials
	briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	Two (2) timers will be used per lane.
	The host club will strive provide at least 1 timer per lane.
	• Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.
	An online Volunteer Signup will be sent to each participating club.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2021 HARVEST MOON - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
