 the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID19.
- By choosing to attend this meet you agree to comply with all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, the State of Maryland and Prince George's County.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use is minimized to emergency use only.
- Before entering the facility, participants are required assess their own health for symptoms and exposure to COVID-19. Attendees will only be permitted entrance if answering "no" to the following questions:
 - Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
 - o Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the past 14 days?
 - Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who has within the past 14 days?
- All attendees (coaches, officials, volunteers and athletes) must complete and turn in a COVID
 waiver and health screening form before they are permitted to enter the facility. The waiver will
 be distributed to participating teams.
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) must wear a mask to enter the facility
 and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming
 up/cooling down. Masks must be affixed to the face without hands and must cover the nose and
 mouth.
- No one with symptoms of COVID-19 is permitted in the facility.
- All attendees should maintain a minimum of six (6) feet distance from all other participants whenever possible.
- All attendees should bring a filled, reusable (non-glass) water bottle to the meet.
- Athletes should bring a minimum of two masks and a container or waterproof type bag to place their mask in while swimming.
- Spectators will not be permitted into the facility. Competition will be live streamed.
- Only swimmers, coaches, meet volunteers, and officials will be permitted on the pool deck.
- Swimmers will be assigned to an area throughout the facility (pool deck or bleachers) or in one of the heated tents. No chairs on deck for athletes. <u>Athletes assigned to the tent should bring</u> <u>chairs.</u>
- During warm-ups, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach their assigned warm up lane
 and entry end and just before they enter the pool. They will place their mask in their waterproof
 holder to store their mask while they swim. They will put their mask back on as soon as they exit
 the pool. After warm-up, coaches will direct swimmers to exit the pool. Swimmers will proceed

clockwise along the pool deck to return to their designated seating area to prepare for competition. During competition, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach the starting blocks. They will place their mask in their waterproof holder to store their mask while they swim. They will put their mask back on before leaving the starting area. For the 25 yard events, volunteers will move the baskets containing masks to the finish end of the pool where the swimmers will immediately put them back on after exiting the pool. All swimmers must remain in their designated area until they are called for their events, and they must return to their area immediately following their event. 18 lanes will be available for warm-up, with a maximum of six (6) swimmers per lane and maintaining appropriate distance as required by applicable local guidelines and in accordance with USA Swimming guidelines. A maximum of 108 swimmers is allowed in the pool during warmups. Each session will be limited to 300 athletes. Limited hospitality may be offered for coaches and officials. Any attendee (swimmer, coach, official, volunteer) not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet. We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID-19 after attending the meet. **RULES** Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. **EVENT RULES** All events are timed finals. Athletes may enter a maximum of five (5) events. Swimmers will complete at the age attained on December 18, 2021. No deck entries will be accepted. WARM-UP The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director • may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments. No more than six (6) swimmers per lane. No more than 108 swimmers allowed in the pool

	during warm-ups.
	Continuous warm-up lanes will be available.
SUPERVISION	• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
SEEDING	Events will be pre-seeded.
AWARDS	Ribbons awarded for 1 st - 8 th places.
	Ribbons awarded to 6 & Under, for all 25 and 50 yard events.
	• Ribbons awarded to 7 – 8 year olds for all 25 and 50 yard events.

CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	No spectators permitted.
OFFICIALS	Officials interested in volunteering should contact Craig Meledick at craig8@comcast.net .
	Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
TIMERS	One timer (per club) is required for every 25 entries. Each club is required to submit names of timers in accordance with team entry. FAST will provide one timer per lane.
	Acceptance of Club entry is based upon compliance with the above.
SPECIAL NOTE	• In addition to timing requirements. Each club must provide 3 additional volunteers to assist with lane checking and timing during the 25 yard events.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	• Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director, fairlandswim@comcast.net .
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2021 Splash and Dash - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).
	Event file can be found on the PVS website.
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
