We have taken enhanced health and safety for all attending this meet, however we cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19. All attending this meet must follow all posted instructions while in attendance. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID-19 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending this meet, you acknowledge the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to COVID-19. By choosing to attend this meet you agree to comply with all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and Prince William County. COVID-19 Outside seating is permitted. **PROTOCOLS** All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, volunteers, spectators) must wear a mask to enter the facility and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming up/cooling down and at any time 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained in any area of the facility. Swimmers should bring a minimum of two masks and a container or waterproof type bag to place their mask in while swimming. Masks must be worn by athletes while sitting in the bleacher area. Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use should be minimized. Spectators will not be permitted into the facility. The meet will be live streamed on YouTube. www.youtube.com/occoquanswimming Before signing up your young swimmer, please consider that they can manage themselves for the duration of the meet with just their swim coach overseeing them, including being able to visit the bathroom independently. Each session will be limited to 192 swimmers. Teams will be assigned to a designated seating area. Access to the outside seating area will be through the main entrance. Entry & exit for all participants, volunteers, and coaches will be through the main pool entrance. Before entering the facility participants, coaches, and volunteers are asked to assess their own

health by answering the following questions and only enter the facility if they are confident they

have not been in contact with anyone or are themselves feeling any of the symptoms of COVID-19 as described by the US CDC.

- Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
- o Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
- Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who has in the past 14 days?
- No one with symptoms of COVID-19 is permitted in the facility.
- One timer will be assigned to each lane as a backup timer for the 11 & over sessions and two timers will be assigned to each lane for the 10 & under sessions.
- Prior to each race, athletes will leave their assigned spot, walk along the turn end of the pool, down the lane 1 side of the pool, and continue behind the blocks, with staging along the pool deck.
- Swimmers will leave their assigned spot, walk along the turn end of the pool, down the lane 1 side of the pool, and continue behind the blocks.
- For warm-ups, swimmers for each session will be assigned to one of two warm-up groups, no more than 96 swimmers in each group. Each group will be assigned an arrival time. Swimmers will not be permitted into the building prior to their arrival time. Swimmers will proceed to their assigned seating area, prepare to enter the pool, and follow marshals' and coaches' directions to enter the pool while respecting social distancing guidelines.
- During warm-ups, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach their assigned warm up lane
 and entry end and just before they enter the pool. They will place their mask in their waterproof
 holder to store their mask while they swim. They will put their mask back on as soon as they exit
 the pool.
- Dive over starts will be used for subsequent heats.
- Staging for swimmers during competition will be:
 - Heat 1 is at the blocks and will swim.
 - o Heat 2 is under the scoreboard and will remain there until Heat 1 starts swimming.
 - Heat 3 is staging under the flag until directed to move to under the scoreboard (after Heat 2 proceeds to the starting blocks)
- During competition, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach the starting blocks. They will place their mask in their waterproof holder to store their mask while they swim. They will put their mask back on before leaving the starting area.
- The 25 yard events will start from the turn end (no blocks). Masks will be delivered from the start end to the finish end.
- Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired) for the 500 freestyle. Swimmers must provide their own timer for the 400 IM. The timers and counters may be provided by anyone that is willing to help and can enter the facility following the above protocol.
- Additional sanitation will take place as well as sanitation stations will be available in various locations throughout the facility.
- HEPA Filtration system is used in high traffic rooms for additional air purification.
- UV Light is used along with chlorine to disinfect the water constantly.
- We request that all attendees notify the meet director as soon as possible if they have tested
 positive for COVID-19, shown symptoms or have been in contact with anyone exposed to COVID19 after attending the meet.

RULES

- Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are
 subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"),
 and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in
 the conduct of this competition.

	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	 The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
	No deck entries will be accepted.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	All events are swum fast to slow based on entry times
	8 events max the meet (4 events max Saturday, 4 event max Sunday).
	• Swimmers must swim in their designated age group based on their age on January 15, 2022.
	 Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired) for the 500 freestyle. Swimmers must provide their own timer for the 400 IM.
	The meet director reserves the right to change the format of the meet to best accommodate the space and time for each session.
	Deck entries will be permitted if space is available.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	• All events will be pre-seeded on Friday, January 14 at 3:00pm. All changes must be submitted no later than 12pm on Friday, January 14.
	The meet director will determine if a positive check in system needs to take place.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director may determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	• No more than 12 swimmers per lane will be permitted and warm up protocol will be provided prior to the meet for coaches.
	• At least 2 lanes in the 25 yard pool will be available for most prelims sessions for continuous warm up or cool down options. (no more than 12 swimmers per lane).
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.
	Meet Marshals will be used to patrol the facility as well as help with crowd control and COVID regulation compliance.
SEEDING	All events, except those that may be determined by the meet director to require positive check in, will be pre-seeded.
	All events will be seeded fastest to slowest.
	The meet director may determine if combining or splitting sessions is needed to provide additional competitive opportunities and time between events.
SCORING	No team scores will be kept.
PROGRAMS	Programs will not be sold; however, the meet will be available on Meet Mobile and a meet program will be posted on the OCCS website on Friday, January 14.

ENTRY PROCEDURES				
	• Include in the subject of the email, "Winter Wonderland - ****" with the club's initials in place of			
	the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.			
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.			
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).			
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.			
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.			
	• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.			
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
