- We have taken enhanced health and safety measures for all attending this meet, however we
 cannot guarantee that you will not become infected with COVID-19. All attending this meet
 must follow all posted instructions while in attendance. An inherent risk of exposure to COVID19 exists in any public place where people are present. By attending this meet, you acknowledge
 the contagious nature of COVID-19 and voluntarily assume all risks related to exposure to
 COVID-19.
- By choosing to attend this meet you agree to comply with all health and safety mandates and guidelines of USA Swimming, Potomac Valley Swimming, the Commonwealth of Virginia, and Arlington County.

COVID-19 PROTOCOLS

- Athletes should arrive and depart in their suits. Locker room use is minimized to emergency use only.
- Before entering the facility, participants are required to assess their own health for symptoms and exposure to COVID-19. Attendees will only be permitted entrance if answering "no" to the following questions:
 - Do you feel any of the symptoms that fall under the symptoms of COVID-19 (fever over 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, etc.)?
 - Has anyone in your family been sick or diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days?
 - Has someone you've been in contact with been diagnosed with COVID-19 or been in contact with someone who has within the past 14 days?
- All attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) must wear a mask to enter the facility
 and throughout the facility, with the exception of athletes when competing or warming
 up/cooling down. Masks must be affixed to the face without hands and must cover the nose and
 mouth.
- All attendees should bring a filled, reusable (non-glass) water bottle to the meet.
- Athletes should bring a minimum of two masks and a container or waterproof type bag to place their mask in while swimming.
- Spectators will be permitted into the facility.
- Only swimmers, coaches, meet volunteers, and officials will be permitted on the pool deck.
- Each session will be limited to 170 swimmers. Total attendees (athletes, coaches, officials, and volunteers) for each session is limited to 300.
- During warm-ups, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach their assigned warm up lane and entry end and just before they enter the pool. They will place their mask in their waterproof holder to store their mask while they swim. They will put their mask back on as soon as they exit the pool.
- During competition, swimmers will wear their masks until they reach the starting blocks. They will place their mask in their waterproof holder to store their mask while they swim. They will

put their mask back on before leaving the starting area.

- All swimmers must remain in their designated area until they are called for their events, and they must return to their area immediately following their event.
- Limited hospitality may be offered for coaches and officials.
- Coaches, volunteers, and officials will use the All Gender Restrooms for restroom purposes. Athletes will use the locker rooms for restroom purposes.
- Swimmers will be assigned to a seating area on the pool deck or in half of the spectator bleachers.
- Spectator will enter the facility using the main/front door and proceed up the stairs to the bleachers.
- One-way traffic flow will be implemented. Swimmers will enter the deck area and proceed to
 their assigned seating area. Swimmers will remain in their assigned team area until they are
 ready to swim. Swimmers will walk around the pool on the spectator side of the pool to the
 starting blocks. At the completion of their races, swimmers will exit the pool and walk around on
 the scoreboard side of the pool to return to their assigned area.
- Entry and exit from continuous warm-up will be from the bleacher side of the pool.
- Staging for swimmers during competition will be:
 - Heat 1 is at the blocks and will swim
 - Heat 2 is staged behind the blocks, near the wall
 - Heat 3 is staged against wall on the deep end of the scoreboard side of the pool until directed to move to where Heat 2 is standing (after Heat 1 has started and Heat 2 steps forward to the starting blocks).
- Any attendee (swimmer, coach, official, volunteer) not following the meet protocols will be subject to immediate removal from the meet.
- We request that all attendees notify the appropriate meet director as soon as possible if they have tested positive for COVID-19 or shown symptoms after attending the meet.

RULES

- Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
- All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
- No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
- In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
- Deck changes are prohibited.
- Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being
 proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When
 unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's
 legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
- Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- Dive-over starts will not be used.
- The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats,

	swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.		
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All Relays will need to be checked in by the end of warm up for each session.		
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will assign times and lane assignments for the warm up.		
	• Continuous warm up/ warm down lanes will be available. Coaches must monitor their swimmers while in these lanes.		
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and cleaning up for their team areas.		
SEEDING	All individual events will be pre-seeded. Relays will be seeded after check in.		
SCORING	This meet will not be scored.		
AWARDS	• Individual events will be awarded first through tenth place. Relay events will be awarded for first place through fourth place. A heat award will be given to the winner of each individual heat.		
PROGRAMS	Meet programs will be sent out to teams prior to the meet.		
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them at all times.		
SPECTATOR ENTRY FEE	There will be no spectator entry fee		
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.		
	 Officials interested in volunteering should contact AAC Officials Chair Mike McCarthy, <u>mccartmt@gmail.com</u>. 		
	 Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials briefing will precede each session during warm-ups. 		
TIMERS	Two (2) timers per lane.		
	• Participating clubs are requested to provide timers in proportion to their entries. One timer is requested for each 25 entries.		
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.		
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2022 Winter Gator Mini Meet - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.		
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.		
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).		
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.		
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.		
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
