All athletes shall compete at the age attained on the first day of the meet.

DISABILITY SWIMMERS	PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide
	advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.
	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the <u>USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</u> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts may be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	 All events in Sessions 1 and 5 will follow a prelims/finals format except for the 200 Breaststroke, 400 IM, 200 Butterfly, and 400 Freestyle. There will be three heats swum at finals for each Preliminary event. Heats will be swum in the following order: C, B, A.
	Events will be pre-seeded using LCM times. Athletes that do not have LCM entry times will be seeded with NT.
	• All swimmers must provide their own timer for the 400m IM and 400m Free and all events taking place on Saturday, June 29, 2024.
	Athletes participating in Session 4 may swim a maximum of two events/session.
	• Swimmers 13 & over may enter and compete in up to three (3) events each day, with a maximum of seven (7) events for the meet.
	• Swimmers 12 & under may enter and compete in up to four (4) three (3) events each day, with a maximum of nine (9) seven (7) events for the meet.
	Deck entries will be accepted on a limited basis. No new heats will be created to accommodate a deck-entered swimmer.
POSITIVE CHECK-IN	 All events 400m and longer will be positive check-in. The meet director will communicate positive check-in schedule to all clubs after entries are received.

WITHDRAWING FROM FINALS	• Swimmers who do not wish to swim in the Final must "Scratch" from the event by completing the Scratch from Finals form within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers for the A, B, and C finals, if scheduled.
	• Swimmers may declare an "Intent to Scratch" by completing the Scratch from Finals form within 30 minutes of the announcement of qualifiers for the A, B, and C finals, if scheduled, indicating "Intent". Intents to Scratch must be confirmed within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the swimmer's last preliminary event of the session or they will be automatically seeded into Finals.
	 If a swimmer fails to properly scratch from an event and does not appear for the Final event, they shall be removed from their next scheduled individual event.
	• Coaches should make sure their contact information is up to date. The meet director will contact the coach or team representative should a swimmer scratch into finals.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	• There will be one long course lane available for continuous warm-up/warm down while the meet is taking place. No one will swim in the lane adjacent to the competition lanes.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
	Spectators are not allowed on the pool deck; swimmers may not bring personal chairs on the pool deck; coaches may bring a personal chair on the pool deck.
SEEDING	 All preliminary and timed finals events, except for positive check-in events, will be pre-seeded at 6:00pm the evening prior to the session. Known scratches may be sent to the Meet Director (<u>fairfaxfoxes@gmail.com</u>).
	Saturday events will be seeded fastest to slowest, all other events will use standard seeding.
SCORING	The meet will not be scored.
AWARDS	 All swimmers will receive a commemorative Summer Solstice bag tag (that they will need for entry on deck at St. James). All heat winners will receive a Summer Solstice LC Champs cap.
PROGRAMS	Meet programs and results will be available on Meet Mobile.
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer, or other position are not permitted on deck or in the facility before, during, or after the meet.
	 Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, deck officials and volunteers will be permitted on deck. Coaches and Officials should always have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.
	Athletes will need to present their Summer Solstice bag tag for entry to the pool deck.
OFFICIALS	 Officials will be coordinated by the Meet Referee, Tim Husson (<u>tim.husson@gmail.com</u>). Officials interested in volunteering should complete the <u>Online Signup</u> or email the Meet Referee. Walkon officials are welcome.
	A comprehensive officials' briefing will be conducted prior to each session.
TIMERS	Two (2) timers per lane.
	Each club will be required to provide timers in proportion to the number of entries. The Meet Director will assign timer requirements to each club after entries have been received. The Meet Director will notify clubs of their timer requirements by email. each.
	Lane assignments will be made in advance.
	Timers should report to the timers meeting 20 minutes before the start of the session.

	• In the body of your email, provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (emaphone, officials contact).		
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.		
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.		
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.		
	 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 per occurrence by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the fine is paid.
