

ELIGIBILITY	Open to all registered Potomac Valley Swimmers.		
	<ul> <li>No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 302.</li> </ul>		
DISABILITY SWIMMERS	<ul> <li>PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.</li> </ul>		
TIMING SYSTEM	Semi-automatic timing (buttons primary) will be used.

RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.				
	<ul> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> </ul>				
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.				
	• In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> , the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.				
	Deck changes are prohibited.				
	• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.				
	Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.				
	Dive-over starts will NOT be used.				
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.				
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.				
	Athletes may enter no more than three (3) events.				
	Deck entries will be accepted to fill empty lanes only. No new heats will be created. Evidence of current USA registration is required for deck entries.				
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.				
WARM-UP	<ul> <li>The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will assign warm-ups, including timer/lane assignments.</li> </ul>				
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.				
SEEDING SCORING	All events are pre-seeded.  This most is not seered.				
AWARDS	<ul> <li>This meet is not scored.</li> <li>For individual events, ribbons will be awarded for 1st to 8th place.</li> </ul>				
	<ul> <li>For individual events, ribbons will be awarded for 1st to 8th place.</li> <li>For 100 yd. events, ribbons will be awarded to the following age groups: 9&amp;10-year-olds, 8 &amp; under.</li> <li>For 50 yd. events, ribbons will be awarded to the following age groups: 9&amp;10-year-olds, 8-year-olds, and 7 and under.</li> <li>For 25 yd. events, ribbons will be awarded to 8-year-olds, 7-year-olds and 6 and under. Ribbons will be awarded for each session separately.</li> </ul>				
PROGRAMS	<ul> <li>Programs will be made available for coaches and officials at the meet; and will be available on Meet Mobile for \$3.00.</li> </ul>				
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.				
SPECTATOR ENTRY	• Limited Spectator Seating will be available in the bleacher area on a first come, first served basis.				
FEE	ONE SPECTATOR PER ATHLETE will be allowed to enter				

OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.

	<ul> <li>Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.</li> </ul>				
TIMERS	VOLUNTEER ASSIGNMENTS WILL BE MADE BASED ON PROPORTION OF ENTRIES. The Signup Genius will be emailed to teams in advance.				
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.				
ENTRY PROCEDURES	<ul> <li>Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.</li> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "NCAP Candy Cane - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.</li> </ul>				
	Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.				
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).				
	Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.				
	Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.				
	The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.				
	• Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.
