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	• Entries in the 500 Freestyle and 400 IM may be limited to 4 heats each (split equally between female and male swimmers). If necessary, this will be done based on verifiable proof of time. Any swimmer removed from these events due to time constraints will be provided the opportunity to enter another event, provided it does not create a new heat and does not violate any applicable entry limits.
	 Deck entries will only be accepted for swimmers already in the meet and will be accepted in empty lanes only. No new heats will be created.
	The Meet Director reserves the right to alter the format of the meet after entries are received to best accommodate timelines, space availability.
POSITIVE CHECK IN	The first event in each session will be pre-seeded. All other events may be positive check-in, utilizing a check-in sheet organized by team. The check-in will be due 10 minutes prior to the start of each session. Prior to the meet, coaches of participating teams will be informed what events will use positive check-in.
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
SEEDING	Only the first event each session will be pre-seeded. Other events will be seeded as described above.
