<b>FACILITY</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Occoquan Swim Academy</b>          10371 Central Park Drive          Manassas, VA 20110          (703) 393-2632</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The competition pool at Occoquan Swim Academy is 8 lanes, 25 yards.</li> <li>Water depth range of 7.0' at the starting end and 6' 7" at the turning end.</li> <li>Warm up and cool down lanes (5) will be available during both sessions.</li> <li>The meet hosts shall ensure the required course dimensions.</li> </ul>																								
<b>ENTRY DEADLINE</b>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Thursday, October 3, 2024, 8:00pm</b></p> <p>IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.</p>

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<b>ELIGIBILITY</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Open to all registered and invited teams from USA Swimming. No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i> Article 302.</li> </ul>																								
<b>DISABILITY SWIMMERS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the <a href="#">Inclusion Policy</a> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the session referee of any disability prior to competition.</li> </ul>																								
<b>TIMING SYSTEM</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Automatic Timing (touchpads primary) will be used.</li> </ul>																								
<b>RULES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.</li> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming <a href="#">Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy</a> ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</li> </ul>																								

	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> <li>• Deck changes are prohibited.</li> <li>• Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> <li>• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.</li> <li>• Dive-over starts will be used for all events.</li> <li>• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 &amp; U events per Rule 205.3.1F.</li> </ul>
<b>EVENT RULES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All events are timed finals.</li> <li>• Swimmers are encouraged to swim all five races to add up a pentathlon ‘time’.</li> <li>• Swimmers may swim up to five (5) individual events and two (2) relays for the meet</li> <li>• Teams may enter up to 2 relay teams as 13-14 age group and 2 relay teams as 15 &amp; over age group.</li> <li>• Results will be ranked/scored as 13-14 events and 15 &amp; over events.</li> <li>• Swimmers must swim in their designated age group based on their age on October 12, 2024.</li> <li>• Deck entries will be accepted into empty lanes only. No new heats will be created.</li> <li>• Evidence of current USA Swimming registration required for deck entries.</li> <li>• The Meet Director reserves the right to change the format of the meet to best accommodate the space and time for each session.</li> </ul>
<b>SEEDING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All Saturday events will be pre-seeded on Saturday, October 12 at 6am. All changes must be submitted no later than 12am on Saturday, October 12.</li> <li>• All Sunday events will be pre-seeded on Sunday, October 13 at 6am. All changes must be submitted no later than 12am on Sunday, October 13.</li> </ul>
<b>MEDICAL ASSISTANCE</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.</li> </ul>
<b>WARM-UP</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.</li> </ul>
<b>SUPERVISION</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.</li> <li>• Meet Marshals will be used to patrol the facility and help with crowd control as well as safety regulation compliance.</li> </ul>
<b>SEEDING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• All events will be pre-seeded and swum fastest to slowest based on entry time. Coach entered times are permitted.</li> <li>• The Meet Director may determine if combining or splitting sessions is needed to provide additional competitive opportunities and time between events.</li> </ul>
<b>SCORING</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Pentathlon scores will be shared at the conclusion of the meet.</li> <li>• Team scoring will be <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ 9-7-6-5-4-3-2-1 for individual events</li> <li>○ 18-14-12-10-8-6-4-2 for relay events</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>AWARDS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• No awards will be given.</li> </ul>
<b>PROGRAMS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Programs will not be sold; however, the meet will be available on Meet Mobile and a meet program will be posted on the OCCS website each morning of the meet once events are seeded.</li> </ul>

<b>CREDENTIALS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position may not be permitted in the facility. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on deck unless space permits to allow spectators. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.</li> </ul>								
<b>OFFICIALS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke &amp; Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.</li> <li>Officials interested in volunteering should complete the <a href="#">Online Signup Form</a> or contact John Avelis (<a href="mailto:javelis3@gmail.com">javelis3@gmail.com</a>)</li> <li>Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.</li> </ul>								
<b>TIMERS &amp; VOLUNTEERS</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Two timers per lane on Saturday, one timer per lane is required for Sunday's events.</li> <li>Timers and volunteers will be required to sign up prior to the meet and will be required to adhere to all MAAPP 2.0 policies.</li> <li>Volunteer brief will be available prior to the start of the sessions.</li> <li>Swimmers may be required to provide their own timer.</li> </ul>								
<b>ENTRY PROCEDURES</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director, <a href="mailto:meets@swimoccs.org">meets@swimoccs.org</a>.</li> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "Medley 2- ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.</li> <li>Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.</li> <li>In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact).</li> <li>Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.</li> <li>Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.</li> <li>The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.</li> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.</li> </ul>
