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#### **RULES** Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. Deck changes are prohibited. Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Dive-over starts will be used. The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. Waiver letter from USA-S for 2024 meet format submitted to **EVENT RULES** All events are timed finals. Crescendo Freestyle Relay will be swum in the following order: 9 year old 50 Freestyle, 11 year old 50 Freestyle, 13 year old 50 Freestyle, 14 year old 50 Freestyle, 12 year old 50 Freestyle, 10 year old 50 Freestyle. Please create an aggregate time for seeding purposes. Entries must be submitted in Short Course Yards times, from USA Swimming sanctioned, approved or observed competition. Teams may enter a maximum of 4 athletes per event, except where noted in the event schedule. Swimmers may enter a maximum of 6 events total, but may not enter or compete in more than 2 per session. Teams may enter a maximum of 2 relay teams per event. If a team cannot fill an event with 4 single age swimmers, athletes within the USA Swimming Motivational Time Standard defined age groups may be permitted to fill open single age entry slots. These swimmers will not count towards scoring. Contact the Meet Director to request this option. **POSITIVE CHECK IN** The 500 Free, 1000 Free and 400 IM will require positive check-in on deck. Check-in deadlines will be shared with teams no later than Wednesday October 30. Swimmers failing to positively check-in will not be seeded into the event. Athletes that positive check-in, are seeded in the event and fail to swim the event will be barred from all competition for the remainder of the session (both individual and relay events). WARM-UP The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. Lane assignments and assigned times will be sent to coaches and teams prior to Wednesday October 30, 2024.

SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
	Only those coaches who have current, valid USA Swimming credentials will be permitted to act in a coaching capacity at this meet. Coaches with expired or non-current credentials will be required to leave the deck area.
SEEDING	All events will be preseeded, except for the 500 Free, 1000 free, and 400 IM.

	Any event in which an athlete participated illegally will be rescored and re-awarded
CREDENTIALS	Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff. There is an AED on site within the pool facility.
OFFICIALS	• Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke & Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.
	Officials interested in volunteering should complete the <u>ONLINE OFFICIALS SIGN UP</u> and note their availability. If availability changes, only the most recently submitted form will be used.
	Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.
	• Include in the subject of the email, "2024 MAAGS - ****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email.
	• Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.
	• In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email,

	phone, officials contact).	
	<ul> <li>Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted. Entries by phone or fax not be accepted.</li> <li>Entries will be processed in order and accepted to the greatest extent possible, without exceeding the 4 hour/session rule.</li> </ul>
