• Officials assigned to this meet should sign in at the recording table 10 minutes before the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.

• The host club will strive to provide at least 1 timer per lane. Each participating club is requested to provide at least one official and 3 timers if entering 25 or more swimmers.
Entries should be submitted using Hy-Tek Team Manager by email to the Meet Director.
• Include in the subject of the email, "Reindeer Mini Meet-***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. Also include training site if your club submits multiple entry files.
• The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.
 Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid by that club.
