	<ul> <li>The pool at Stone Ridge School of the Sacred Heart has 8, 25-yard lanes.</li> </ul>
	Water depth range of 12' at the starting end and 4' at the turning end.
	The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions.
ENTRY	Tuesday January 28th, 2025, at 12:00pm
DEADLINE	IMPORTANT: The above date is the deadline for clubs to submit their entries to the Meet Director. Therefore, clubs usually set an earlier deadline to receive entries from their swimmers. Check with your club for this information.
SCHEDULE	Friday, February 14th
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TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.
RULES	<ul> <li>Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.</li> <li>All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition.</li> <li>No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.</li> </ul>
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	<ul> <li>Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.</li> </ul>
	• Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	A swimmer may enter three (3) events per session, one (1) event on Friday Distance and no more than seven (7) events for the meet.
	All events will be swum fastest to slowest.
	<ul> <li>NTs will not be accepted. Coach's times will be allowed.</li> <li>Break / warm-down periods will be added between events if time permits.</li> <li>Friday's distance session may be limited due to time constraints.</li> <li>Athletes will need their own timer and counter (if desired) for Friday's 400 IM and 500 FR.</li> </ul>
POSITIVE CHECK IN	All events will be pre-seeded.
WARM-UP / WARM- DOWN	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
	<ul> <li>There will be a 15 minute warm-up / warm-down midway through each session - time permitting.</li> <li>There will be a 5 minute break, if needed, on Saturday, Sunday and Monday before the last 11-12 event.</li> </ul>
SUPERVISION	<ul> <li>Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.</li> <li>No chairs will be allowed on deck for athletes. Coaches' chairs will be permitted pending</li> </ul>
	enough safe deck space is available.

MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance,
	please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
SEEDING	Events will be seeded fastest to slowest.
SCORING	No scoring for this meet.
AWARDS	Medals will be awarded for 1st - 8th place.
PROGRAMS	<ul> <li>Programs will be available on Meet Mobile under the meet name "2025 ASA President's Day Classic."</li> </ul>
CREDENTIALS	<ul> <li>Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.</li> </ul>
SPECTATORS	No spectators will be allowed due to limited deck space.

OFFICIALS	<ul> <li>Each participating club is requested to provide at least one table worker or official (Referee Starter, Chief Judge or Stroke &amp; Turn Judge) per session if entering 25 or more splashes.</li> <li>Officials interested in working can sign-up here: <u>ASA President's Day Officials Sign-Up</u></li> <li>Officials volunteering for this meet should sign in at the recording table prior to the start of warm-ups. Certified officials who have not previously volunteered should contact the referee upon arrival to make their services available. A comprehensive officials' briefing will precede each session during warm-ups.</li> </ul>
TIMERS	Timers must check-in 45 minutes prior to the meet start time.
ENTRY PROCEDURES	<ul> <li>Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director.</li> <li>Include in the subject of the email, "2025 ASA President's Day Classic - ***" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files, include the training site in the subject of the email.</li> <li>Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event.</li> <li>In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, official contact).</li> <li>Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted.</li> <li>Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted.</li> <li>The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director.</li> <li>Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid.</li> </ul>
ENTRY FEES	<ul> <li>Athlete Surcharge: \$15.00 per swimmer Individual event fee: \$12.50 per event</li> <li>Entries fees are to be made payable to the "All Star Aquatics". Fees are non-refundable. Entries will not be considered received until all fees are paid.</li> <li>Each team/club is requested to remit only one check or money order to cover entry fees. NO</li> </ul>
