| FACILITY | <p style="text-align: center;">Takoma Aquatic Center 300 Van Buren Street, NW Washington, DC 20012 (202) 576-9534</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• The pool at the Takoma Aquatic Center is a 50m x 25yd pool with two moveable bulkheads. Competition will be held in 8 lanes, 25 yards, running wall to wall.• Water depth range of 7' (lane 1) to 13.5' (lane 8) at the starting end and at the turning end.• The meet hosts will ensure the required course dimensions. | |

| ELIGIBILITY | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Open to all registered USA Swimming members.• No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, Article 302. | |
| SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• PVS and host clubs along with their meet directors are committed to the Inclusion Policy as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance notice of desired accommodations to the Meet Director. | TIMING SYSTEM | <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used. | |

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| RULES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet. • All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. • No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted. • In compliance with <i>USA Swimming Rules and Regulations</i>, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, rest rooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods. • Deck changes are prohibited. • Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement. • Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. • Dive-over starts will be used. • The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F. |
| EVENT RULES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • All events are timed finals and will be swum as mixed gendered. • The meet will be seeded fastest to slowest according to submitted entries regardless of age. • A swimmer may enter a maximum of three (3) events for the entire meet. • 12 & Under swimmers may only participate in one (1) session per day. • Expected timelines will be posted to the PVS web site at www.pvswim.org no later than Wednesday, October 29th, 2025. The meet director reserves the right to combine heats or events based on the number of entries received and meet timeline. |
| POSITIVE CHECK IN | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 500 Freestyle will be pre-seeded. • The 1000 and 1650 will be seeded using positive check-in. Positive check in closure time will be established once entries have been received. Teams will be notified of check in deadline at least 48 hours prior to the start of the meet. |
| WARM-UP | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments. |
| SUPERVISION | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas. |
| SEEDING | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Events will be seeded fastest to slowest. Heats will be swum alternating girls and boys. |
| SCORING | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • This meet will not be scored |

| TIMERS | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swimmers must provide their own timer and lap counter (if desired). One timer per lane. There will be two Head Timers per course. |
| ENTRY PROCEDURES | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Entries should be submitted by email to the Meet Director. Include in the subject of the email, "November Distance Meet - *****" with the club's initials in place of the asterisks. If your club submits multiple entry files include training site in the subject of the email. Include in entry email: entry file, report of entries by name, report of entries by event. In the body of your email provide entry numbers (girls, boys, totals), contact information (email, phone, officials contact). Entries directly from individual team members will not be accepted. Entries by phone or fax will not be accepted. The Meet Director will acknowledge receipt by return email within 24 hours. If acknowledgement is not received in a timely manner, please contact the Meet Director. Any club that enters an unregistered or improperly registered athlete, falsifies an entry in any way, or permits an unregistered coach to represent them will be fined the sum of \$100 by PVS and no further entries will be accepted from that club until the said fine is paid. |
