ELIGIBILITY	Teams Invited: ASA	
	 No swimmer will be permitted to compete in the meet unless the swimmer is registered as an athlete member of USA Swimming as provided in USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, Article 302. 	
SWIMMERS WITH A DISABILITY	 PVS and host clubs along with their Meet Directors are committed to the <u>Inclusion Policy</u> as adopted by the PVS BOD. Athletes with a disability are welcomed and are asked to provide advance written notice of desired accommodations/modifications to the Meet Director and Meet Referee. The athlete (or athlete's coach) is also responsible for notifying the Session Referee in writing of any desired accommodation/modification prior to competition. Athletes requiring special accommodation are asked to complete the form below <u>NECESSARY ACCOMODATIONS</u> 	
TIMING SYSTEM	Automatic timing (touchpads primary) will be used.	
RULES	Current USA Swimming rules shall govern this meet.	
	 All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. 	
	No on-deck USA Swimming registration is permitted.	
	• In compliance with USA Swimming Rules and Regulations, the use of audio or visual recording	

	devices, including a cell phone is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Per PVS policy, the use of equipment capable of taking pictures (e.g., cell phones, cameras, etc.) is banned from behind the starting blocks during the entire meet, including warm up, competition and cool down periods.
	Deck changes are prohibited.
	 Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of the backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.
	 Operation of a drone or any other flying devices is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
	Dive-over starts will be used.
	• The Meet Director and the PVS Technical Committee reserve the right to limit events, heats, swimmers or adjust the format to conform with the 4-hour provision for sessions that include 12 & U events per Rule 205.3.1F.
EVENT RULES	All events are timed finals.
	Meet Director and Meet Referee reserve the right to have positive check-in for all events.
	A swimmer may enter one (1) event.
	Swimmers in the 1650 will get splits off the touch pads at the 500 and 1000yd distances.
	Swimmers must provide their own timer and counter (if desired).
WARM-UP	The prescribed PVS warm-up procedures and safety policies will be followed. The Meet
	Director will determine the structure of warm-up, including times/lane assignments.
SUPERVISION	Coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and for cleaning up their team areas.
MEDICAL ASSISTANCE	 Medical assistance will be provided by the facility staff. If you require medical assistance, please notify a facility lifeguard or a member of the meet staff.
SEEDING	All events will be pre-seeded.
	Events will be seeded fastest to slowest.
SCORING	No scoring for this meet.
AWARDS PROGRAMS	No awards for this meet. No awards for this meet.
PROGRAIVIS	 Programs will be available on Meet Mobile under the meet name "2025 ASA Senior Distance Meet."
CREDENTIALS	 Parents not working the meet as a deck official, volunteer timer or other position are not permitted on deck. Only athletes, USA Swimming certified coaches, and deck officials will be permitted on the deck. Coaches and Officials should have proof of active USA Swimming membership with them.
SPECTATORS	No spectators will be allowed.
