ELIGIBILITY: OPEN TO ALL POTOMAC VALLEY REGISTERED ATHLETES AND INVITED USS ATHLETES. SWIMMERS SHALL COMPETE AT THE AGE ATTAINED ON THE FIRST DAY

OF THE MEET. AN ATHLETE MAY ONLY COMPETE IN HIS OR HER OWN AGE DIVISION.

ENTRIES WILL BE LIMITED TO 2400.

RULES:

CURRENT UNITED STATES SWIMMING RULES SHALL GOVERN THE MEET. ALL EVENTS ARE TIMED TRIALS. A CONTESTANT MAY ENTER NO MORE THAN THREE EVENTS PER DAY, OR SIX EVENTS FOR THE MEET. TIME CONSTRAINTS MAY ALSO

REQUIRE LIMITING THE NUMBER OF EVENTS THAT ARE SWUM.

WARM-UP:

THE PRESCRIBED POTOMAC VALLEY SWIMMING WARM-UP PROCEDURES AND SAFETY POLICIES WILL BE FOLLOWED. THERE WILL BE TWO FORTY (40) MINUTE.

WARM-UP SESSIONS. TEAMS WILL BE NOTIFIED OF THEIR WARM-UP

ASSIGNMENTS.

OFFICIALS:

OFFICIALS ASSIGNED TO THIS MEET SHOULD SIGN IN AT THE RECORDING TABLE AT

THE START OF THE WARM-UP. CERTIFIED OFFICIALS WHO HAVE NOT BEEN

CONTACTED SHOULD VOLUNTEER THEIR SERVICES TO THE REFEREE.

TIMERS:

PARTICIPATING CLUBS ARE REQUIRED TO PROVIDE TIMERS IN PROPORTION TO THEIR ENTRIES. THE NUMBER OF TIMERS BEING COMMITTED MUST BE INCLUDED ON

THE CLUB MASTER ENTRY. THE NUMBER OF TIMERS REQUIRED WILL BE ADJUSTED WHEN

WITH CLUB PROVIDING OTHER OFFICIALS. ACCEPTANCE OF THE CLUB ENTRY IS BASED UPON COMPLIANCE WITH THE ABOVE. HOST CLUBS ARE REQUIRED TO

PROVIDE ONE TIMER PER LANE.

SUPERVISION: COACHES ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE CONDUCT OF THEIR SWIMMERS AND FOR

CLEANSING UP THEIR TEAM AREA.

TEAM AREA: TEAMS WILL BE HOUSED OUTSIDE THE POOL AREA BECAUSE OF LIMITED DECK

SPACE. THE AREAS THEY WILL STAY ARE AIR-CONDITIONED; THEREFORE, APPROPRIATE CLOTHING SHOULD BE WORN TO MAINTAIN BODY WARMTH. WARNING:

ANY CLUE THAT ENTERS AN UNRECISTERED ATHLETE, FALSIFIES IN ANY WAY, OR PERMITS AN UNREGISTERED COACH TO REPRESENT THEM, WILL BE FINED THE SUM OF \$100.00 AND NO FURTHER ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM THAT

CLUB UNTIL THE SAID FINE HAS BEEN PAID.

ADMISSION: THERE IS NO ADMISSION CHARGE, PROGRAMS FOR EACH SESSION WILL BU AVAILABLE FOR \$1.00 EACH. PVS MEMBERS WHO PRESENT THEIR CURRENT FAMILY. MEMBERSHIP CARD ARE ENTITLED TO PURCHASE ONE PROGRAM FOR \$.50. WORKING

OFFICIALS AND COACHES RECEIVE A FREE PROGRAM.

AWARDS:

RIBBONS FIRST THROUGH EIGHTM FLACE FOR INDIVIDUAL, AND FIRST THROUGH THIRD FOR RELAYS. HEAT WINNER RIBBIONS WILL HE GIVEN FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS. PLAQUES FOR FIRST PLACE ONLY WILL BE AWARDED FOR EACH SEX AND EACH AGE GROUP FOR THE FOLLOWING TWO CATEGORIES:

THE HARVEST MOON FULL MOON AWARD

THE CHAMPIONSHIP SCORED WILL BE BASED ON THE ACCUMULATED TIMES FOR THE FOLLOWING SIX EVENTS: 200 INDIVIDUAL MEDILBY, 200 FREESTYLE, 100 BACK, 100 BREAST, AND THE 100 BUTTERFLY. THE SWIMMER MUST LEGALLY SWIM ALL SIX OF THE ABOVE EVENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE

THE HARVEST MOON RALF MOON AWARD

THE CHAMPIONSHIP SCORED WILL BE BASED ON THE ACCUMULATED TIMES FOR THE FOLLOWING SIX EVENTS: 100 INDIVIDUAL MEDLEY, 100 TRESTYLE, 50 BACK, 50 BREAST, AND THE SO BUTTERFLY, THE SWIMMER MUST LEGALLY SWIM ALL SIX OF THE ABOVE EVENTS TO BE ELIGIBLE.

FECS:

PEES FOR INDIVIDUAL EVENTS ARE \$2.50, RELAYS ARE \$5.00. EACH CLUB IS RECOURSTED TO REACT ONE CHECK TO COVER THE ENTRY FEES FOR THE ENTRY TEAM, PLEASE DO NOT SEND CASH, TELEPHIONE ENTRIES WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. LATE (DECK) ENTRIES ARE \$10.00 PER INDEVENDAL EVENT AND MIST BE SUBMITTED NO LATER THAN 30 MINUTES PRIOR TO THE PRIST EVENT OF EACH SESSION, AND WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED IF YER ENTRY LIME? HAS NOT BEEN REACHED.

ENTREES:

COMPLITER DISK ENTRIES (MY-TEK) REQUIRE A MEET ENTRY REPORT BY SWIMMER. AND A MEET ENTRY MASTER REPORT BY EVENT FROM TEAM MANAGER, ENTRIES MAY ALSO BE SUBMITTED ON THE PVS MASTER ENTRY. ANY TEAM THAT ENTERS MORE THAN 10 SWIMMERS AND DOES NOT USE HY-TEX, WILL INCUR A SURCHARGE OF \$1.00 PER SWIMMER. ALSO SUBMIT A COMPLETED "ENTRY COVER SHEET". A SIGNATURE AND PHONE MUMBER OF A CLUB OFFICIAL MUST BE ENCLUDED WITH ENTRY FOR VALUNATION OF ENTRIES. ALL RELAYS MUST HE SCHMITTED ON A PVS

MASTER ENTRY SHEET PLUS AN ENTRY CARD PER RELAY TEAM, NO DECK ENTRIES WILL BE

ACCEPTED FOR RELAYS.
