Officials Representative Report to the Board January 2010

Attendance at the January Takoma Clinics is as follows: Stroke and Turn = 32 (24 from DCRP—the rest from various clubs); ETS = 25; HyTek = 27. This is a great turnout—what remains to be seen is how many go on and become certified. Several of the DCRP attendees asked if they had to work PVS meets to become certified—I got the impression that they would prefer to work only the Black History Meet. I replied that yes their training session had to be at regular PVS meets.

The clinics have been extremely well attended since Sept 2009 and many new officials have become certified. As shown in Tim Husson's 2008 report (attached), only 30% of 2008 ETS Clinic attendees are now certified (10/34) and 46 % of 2008 Hy-Tek Clinic attendees are now certified (17/37).
