Despite assuring that PVS provided full sets of equipment for the LC Open Meets in June, I failed to provide adequate guidance for the meet directors on equipment setup. One meet was one with pads at both ends, as designed. One meet was run with pads at one end and two-button backup. One meet was run with pads at one end and one-button backup. And one meet was run was buttons as the primary timing system. Better direction needs to be given to meet directors for PVS meets so they are all run the same.

Meet Manager 5 software upgrade (currently in beta) for the PVS license had been purchased. The software was successfully used at the LC Age Group Championships. It will also be used at the LC Senior and Junior Championships.

The new CTS-6 timing console has been delivered. I tested it during the LC Age Group Championships. The Infinity starting systems ordered are on back-order but should be delivered before the new short course season.

Two summer swim leagues (CCSDA and PMSL) are renting PVS equipment for their league championships this summer.

The PVS Officials Committee is overseeing the election of the PVS Officials Representative. The election is taking place during the July championship meets and is being run electronically using BallotBin.com.
