Safety Committee

We still need to do some more marshals training so we make proper use of them at our meets.

Equipment

The PVS equipment is in very good shape. I was very pleased with how the PVS equipment worked at the November Open and the January Distance Mee .

Some equipment is still at Colorado for repair. They still have a backlog. There is no estimate on when we will get the equipment back, but we can still support four simultaneous meets.

I published a manual for configuring the CTS-6 to work with the printers. That has been the biggest problem with the equipment thus far this season.

We have been able to support equipment rentals to some outside organizations (e.g. masters & H.S.). These organizations are now required to pay for the rental in advance.

Technical Committee

Jim Thompson created a spreadsheet again this year for the Age Group showing the number of JO qualifiers after the December meets. It will be updated again in late January.

Officials Committee

Thirty officials' clinics have been held this season. Two more clinics are on the scheduled this month.

PVS had five officials at Winter Nationals and two officials at Winter Junior Nationals.

There has been a lot of activity the last month dealing with the re-certification and re-registration of PVS officials. 287 officials qualified for PVS to pay their 2014 registration by working at least ten sessions at 2013 PVS-sanctioned meets.
