PVS House of Delegates Meeting

May 22, 2013

The PVS website continues to be the primary communications asset for Potomac Valley Swimming. Although meet announcements and meet results are the primary reasons PVS members visit the website, other areas of the website continue to be popular, including the Top Times Lists, PVS records, and the Diversity Committee page.
