Officials Committee Report to the PVS House of Delegates

May 2015

The PVS Officials Committee is responsible for:

- Recruiting, training and certifying officials
- Supervising the officials in the LSC
- Staffing the PVS Championship and National Certification Meets

Some Officials' Statistics from the Last 12 Months:

- As of April 28, PVS has 522 certified officials. This is a slight decrease from last year. All officials
 now need to be registered with USA Swimming as of January 2015. This caused a number of
 non-registered, non-deck officials who were no longer active officials to fall off the list.
- There have been 41 officials clinics held in PVS during the 2014-2015 season. This is an increase of nine over last year. Four on-line clinics were offered this season (3 S&T and 1 Referee) and were well received. PVS instructors also lead numerous summer league S&T clinics that can be used for USA-S certification or recertification.
- There were four Officials Qualifying Meets held under the National Certification program in the last year. A total of 76 evaluations were completed.
 - 2014 LC Senior Championships (16 evaluations)
 - 2014 Tom Dolan Invitational (16 evaluations)
 - o 2015 SC Senior Championships (17 evaluations)
 - 2015 14&U Junior Olympic Championships (27 evaluations)
- 118 PVS officials currently hold a National Certification (N2 or N3). This is an increase of 19 over last year.
- PVS officials were selected to work National Championship and Grand Prix meets in the last year.
- PVS officials were selected for leadership positions at Speedo Sectional meets in the last year.
 This includes meet referee, admin referee, team lead chief judge, deck referee and starter.
- PVS provided its share of officials for the Eastern Zone Age Group meets including both the meet referee and admin referee for the LC Zone Meet.
- PVS has certified 17 Administrative Officials under the USA-S certification program. As of September 1, 2014, all meets must include a certified Administrative Official as one of the required officials [rule 102.10]. Additional AOs are needed in PVS to be able to cover all the meets we run.
- PVS offers an Officials Education Travel Stipend for working Zone, Sectional, Grand Prix and National meets. During the last twelve months, PVS provided 30 stipends.

Other Officials News:

- PVS provided officials for the USMS Nationals at UMD in August 2014.
- PVS provided numerous officials for Special Olympics meets
- The Officials Committee continues to use the monthly newsletter, the PVS website and an email list to communicate with all PVS officials.

Notes:

- PVS pays for the re-registration of officials that work at least ten sessions during the previous calendar year. 342 PVS officials qualified for this benefit for the 2015 registration year.
- PVS pays for the Background Screening for officials after they have worked a minimum number of sessions. PVS also pays for Background Screening Renewals for officials in good standing.
- The Officials Committee is continually working to improve the training and mentoring process for officials. For the first time, all Apprentice S&T Officials must have a final evaluation before becoming certified.
