Equipment

- Equipment Manager, Carrie Tupper, has done a very good job managing and maintaining the PVS equipment. Meet hosts and meet referees can count on a complete set of working equipment.
- Several PVS clubs now won their own timing equipment (semi-automatic). This has cut down on the number of equipment rentals for club-sponsored meets.
- Very little new equipment needed to be purchased in the last year. Additional radios were bought so that a set of radios now includes 10 units. The equipment manager performed minor repairs and a few items were repaired by Colorado Timing Systems.
- PVS now has enough working equipment to support a short course four-meet weekend (i.e. November Open) or a long course two-meet weekend (i.e PVS LC Open).
- Fairland Aquatics Center and the Prince George's Sports and Learning Complex bought new timing equipment and large scoreboards last year. The PVS Equipment Manager has been helping the staff at those pools with their equipment set-up and operation. They have set their rental rates well above PVS rental rates. They will also not allow use of the scoreboards without renting their equipment.
