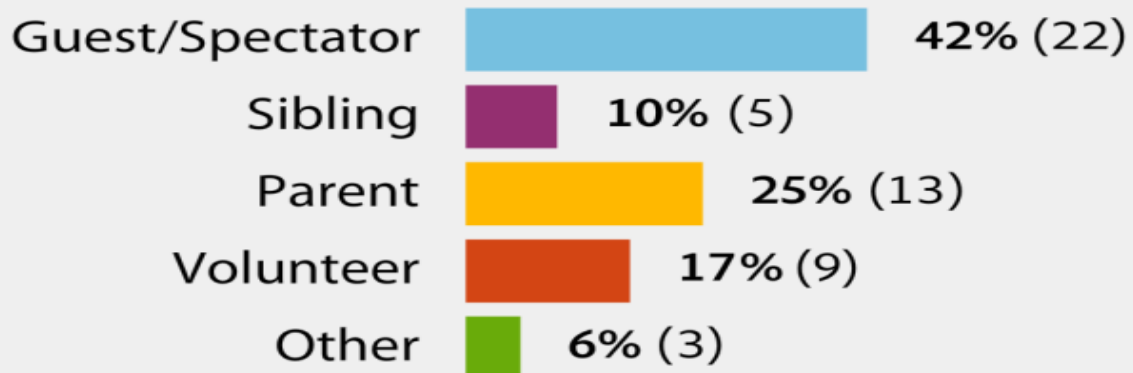

Membership Type



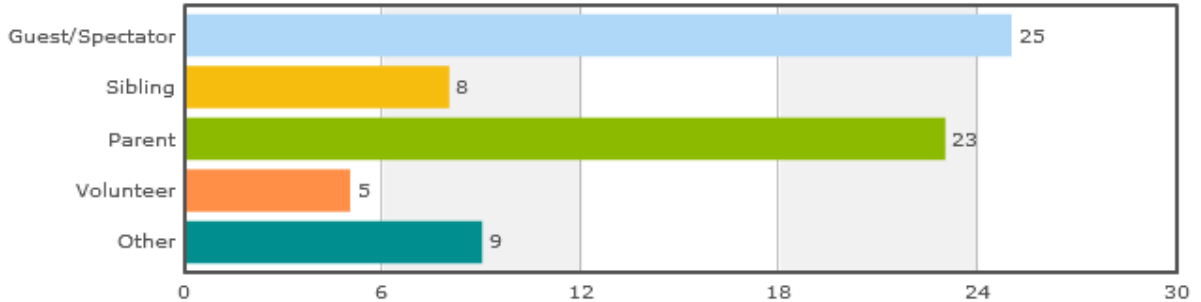
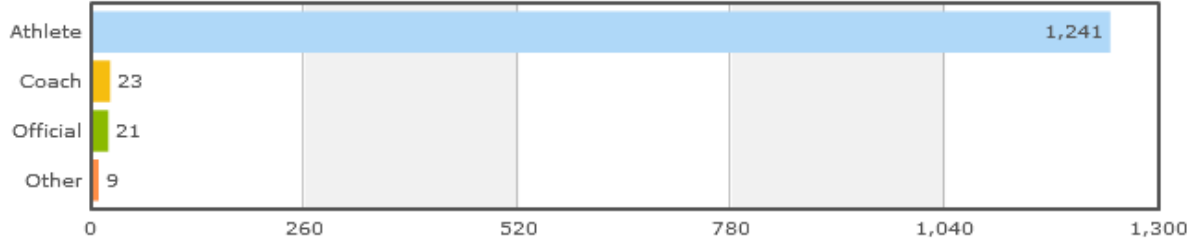

Non-Member Type



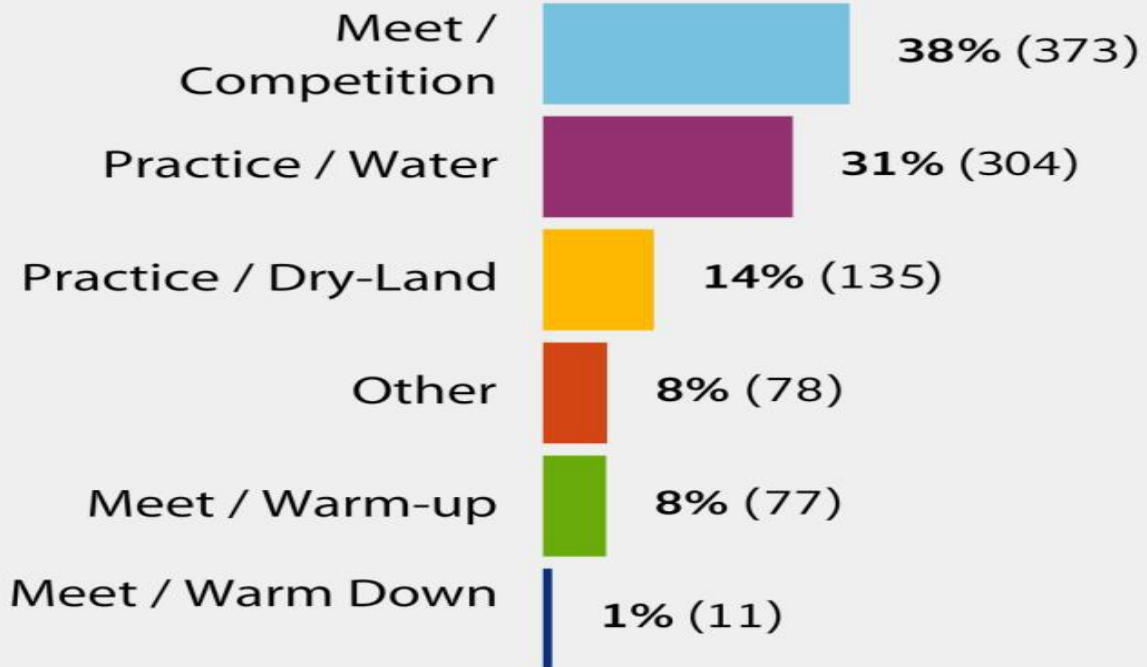

BY MEMBERSHIP/NON-MEMBER TYPE 2nd Half of 2016



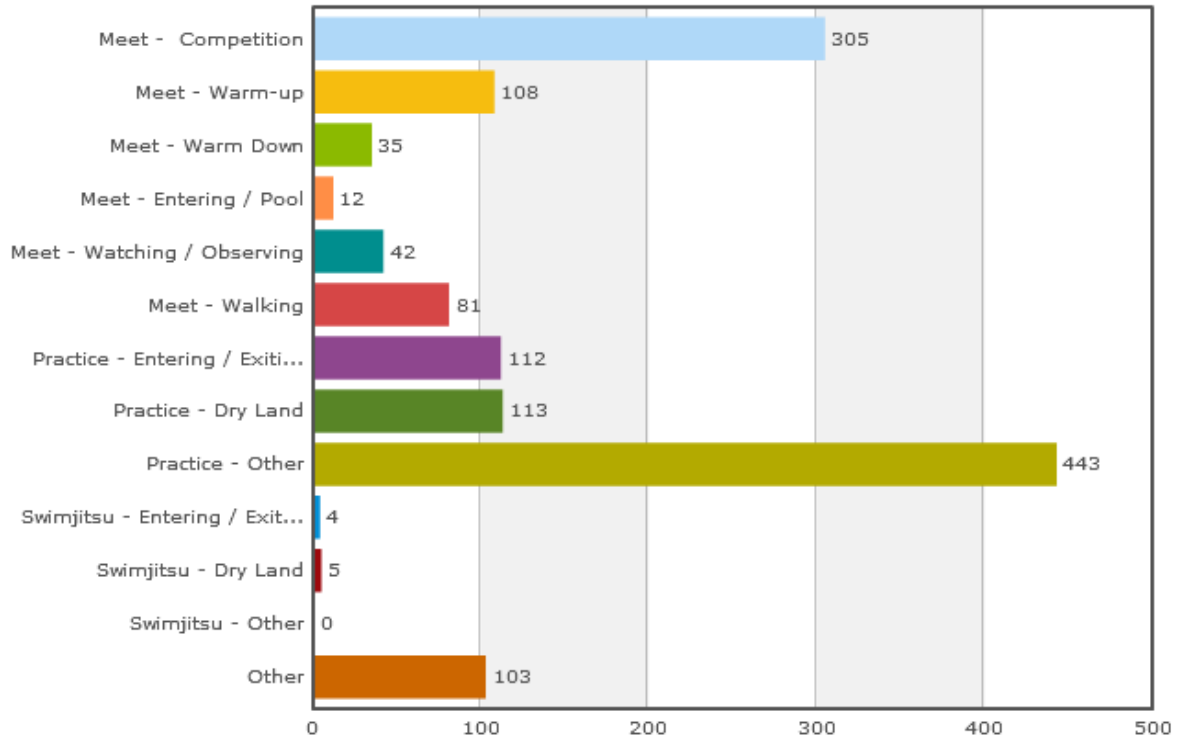

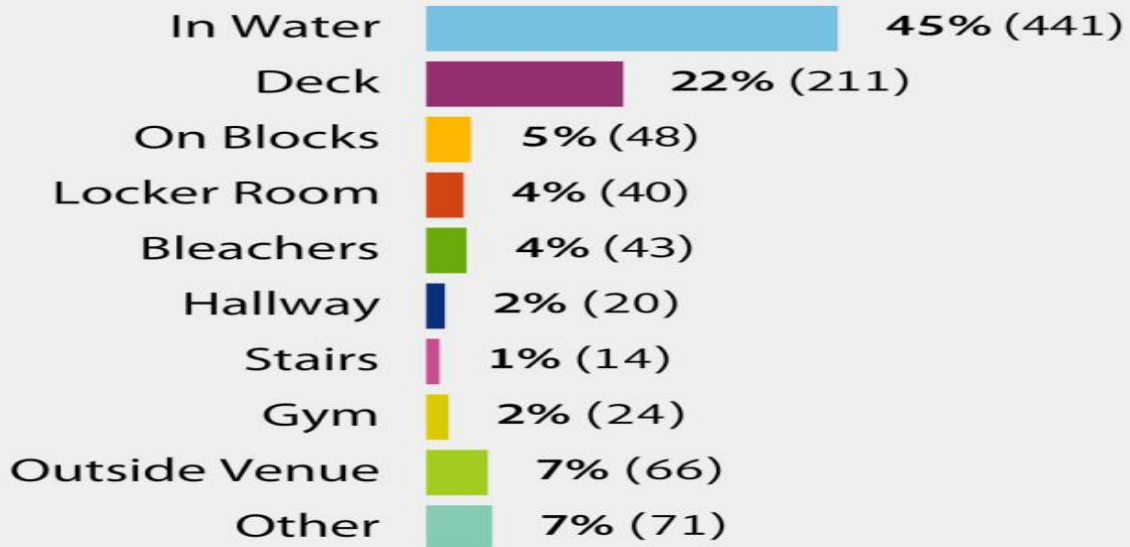

WHEN ACCIDENTS HAPPEN 2nd half of 2016



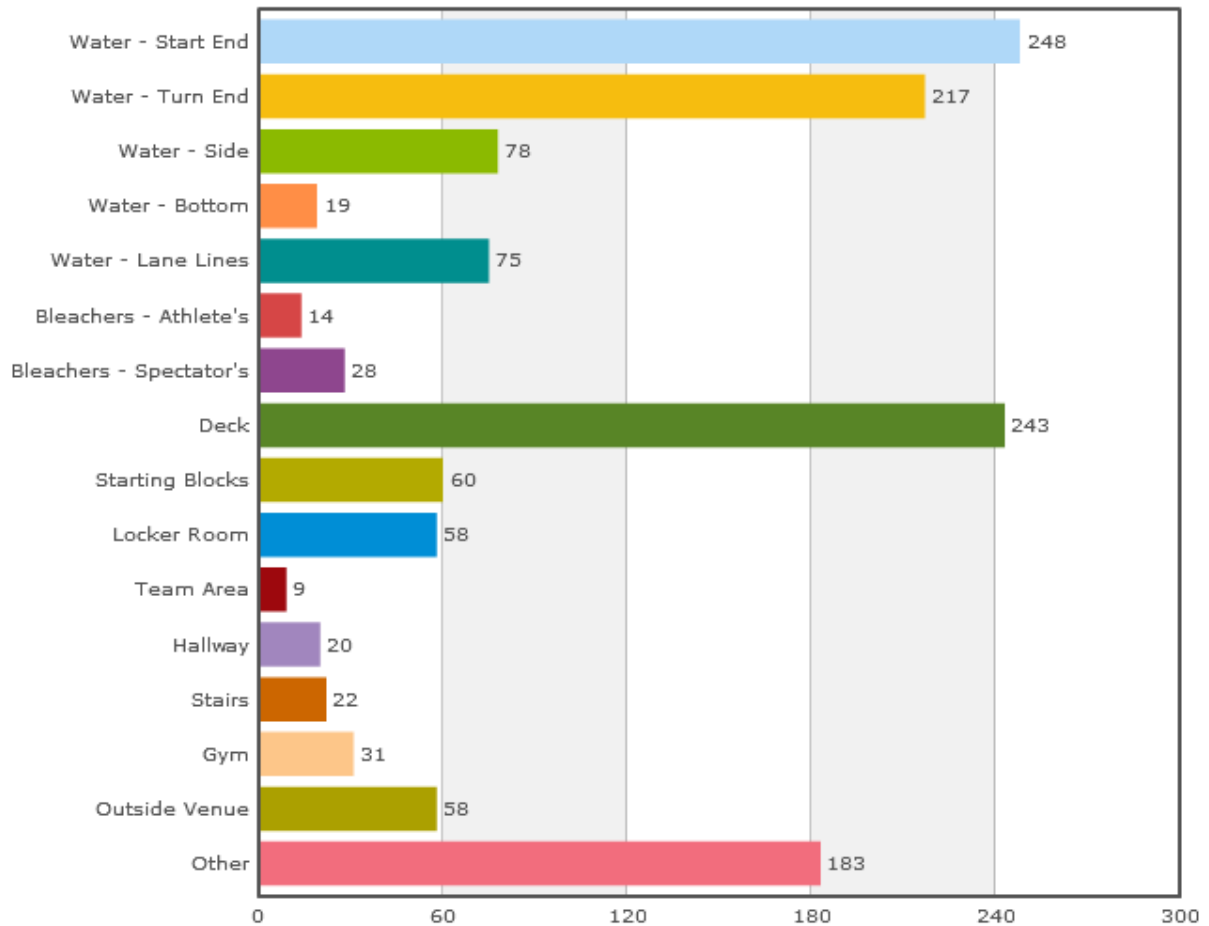
WHERE ACCIDENTS HAPPEN
