Discussion

Discussion

Open water certifications

Discussion

- At the quarterly USA Swimming Official Chairs meeting LSCs were encouraged to create open water certification
- Minimum requirement is a test and clinic per Sandy Drake
- The last open water meet in PVS was hosted in 2010 at National Harbor

Follow-up

• Barb to investigate options and further interest to gage certification development

FINA and World Paralympic Meets Reimbursements

Discussion

- Eligible meets for reimbursement are in Policy and Procedures document
- Include World FINA and World Paralympic meets at the Pro Series level

Apprentice S&T judges completing DQ slips

Discussion

- Encourage apprentice S&T to write slips on the infraction called by the mentor S&T to gain experience
- Encourage flexibility of who is writing DQ slips between S&Ts and CJs to balance experience and speed

Follow-up

 Rich to send email to meet referees, deck referees and chief judges reminding them who writes DQ slips is situational, and to use discretion

Use of radios at age group (developmental) meets

Discussion

• Encourage flexibility on when and how radios are used at meets

Follow-up

 Rich to send email to meet referees and deck referees that they should consider the situational needs of the meet and to use discretion for radio use

Summer clinics for recertification

Discussion

- Each summer league has different requirements for S&T
- MCSL Advanced Referee and Starter clinic should not be eligible for S&T clinic

Use of self-paced S&T clinic and clinic attendance

Discussion

- The use of the self-paced S&T clinic is tabled
- Review the possibility of an intro to officiating video to help with recruitment
- Possibly hold more clinics with one instructor

Follow-up

• Rich asked Pam and Scott to evaluate whether doing more clinics will be helpful

Procedure when an apprentice does not have the requisite sessions for eval or required sessions in previous position before starting apprenticeship or apprenticing before clinic

Discussion

- The start of training is attendance at a clinic and should be within a year of certification
- An apprentice session completed before prerequisites are completed do not count

Follow-up

- Review a process that include OTS session verification by application before an evaluation for starter, chief judge and admin official
- Rich to send email to meet referees and official chairs about what is considered the start of training

Safety concern of walking stroke

Discussion

- Reviewed experience difference between meets
- Recommend use more solid barrier

Follow-up

 Rich to send email to meet referees and meet directors to check barriers for walking stroke when banners are used

Certification subcommittee (Barb)

Discussion

- Update for certification requirements
 - DR certification requires recert S&T test
 - SR recert 4 sessions as SR or higher and 1 session as S&T/CJ
 - DR recert 6 sessions as SR or DR and 1 session as S&T/CJ
 - S&T mentor must have 1 year as S&T
 - AO mentor must have 1 year as AO, AR or DR

• Barb to request website update with updated recertification requirements
